hen Someone Is Announced As Sick: Send them a card, visit them at the hospital, call them to see how things are going (even if it is not the week for your group).

When Precious Souls Are Added to the Body: Introduce yourself to them, welcome them to the family. Learn their face AND their name. Encourage your brethren.

When It Seems Like There's Not Much Taking Place Socially: Invite someone into your home or out to lunch. Sometimes it is up to us to get things going. Why wait on someone to invite you?

When Your Visitation Group Meets On Sunday: Make sure you are in attendance and eager to do what you can to help. Make an effort to use your talents. Encourage other members of your group to be present. There's enough work to go around and we need the participation of each and every member.

When There Aren't Any Home Bible Studies Taking Place That You Know About: Have a Bible study in your home (or singing). You'll be glad you did and so will those who come. There's something special about gathering around the Word in a home. Plan a time and have a study this year.

When Someone Seems Discouraged or Sad: Show them that you really care. Don't just pat them on the back and say, "Buck up Bro!" Offer to listen. You may not have many answers but, just be available. Your genuine concern will be greatly appreciated.

When Someone Is Absent From Our Assembly: Call and let them know you missed them and check to make sure they are not sick or suffering. Don't wait until it is your visitation group week. Tell others about their absence, out of concern. Don't wait until they have been absent several times, it may be too late to help by then.

When the Singing Sounds Hushed or Somewhat Lackluster: Sing out enthusiastically. Look around and smile. Actually sing "to one another" and praise God! Zealous singing is contagious.

When You See a New Face In Our Assembly: Introduce yourself and warmly welcome our guests. Give them a LifeLine and ask them to fill out a welcome card.

When You Think We Need More Evangelism: Talk up the church, the brethren, the Bible classes and invite folks to "come and see."

- Are we not to please men? (Gal. 1:10)

3. IF MEN HAVE RELIGIOUS AUTHORITY, WHY...

- Does Christ claim all authority? (Matt. 28:18)
- Is Christ to be preeminent? (Col. 1:18)

4. IF WE CAN BE SAVED IN ANY NAME, WHY...

- Is salvation only in Christ's name? (Acts 4:12)
- Is the worthy Name mentioned? (Jas. 2:7)

5. IF THE KINGDOM OF CHRIST IS FUTURE WHY...

- Are the obedient in it? (Col. 1:13)


